The inaugural issue of the Journal of the North End Historical Society is issuing a call for papers. The Journal is multi-disciplinary and accepts submissions on a wide range of topics including history, geography, sociology, statistics, biography, and architecture, as well as state-of-the-field essays, book reviews, reviews of films, museum exhibitions, and Web sites. All works must be of relevance to the North End of Boston. The inaugural issue seeks to encompass the widest possible range of North End history, from the early Puritan settlement into the present. We encourage submission on, but do not limit to, topics such as:

- Puritan North End
- Colonial History
- Irish Immigration and Settlement
- The North End's Jewish Community
- Portuguese in the North End
- Sacco and Vanzetti
- Gentrification and Urban Renewal
- Politics and Policy
- Architecture
- Religious History, Festivals, Churches
- Italian and Italian American History

Deadline:

November 1, 2010

Where to Send Your Manuscript:

Two paper copies of the manuscript should be sent to the North End Historical Society, Inc., P.O. BOX 130152, Boston, MA 02113, and with "JNEHS submission" written below this address. An electronic version must be submitted, along with the paper copies, on a CD or DVD, or as an e-mail attachment sent to JNEHS1@gmail.com (please type "JNEHS submission" in the subject line).

All works submitted to the Journal of the North End Historical Society must include a title page with the author's full address, including email, and an abstract on a separate page from the body of the article, which may not be longer than 500 words.

Formatting:

All text, including quotations and endnotes, should be prepared in double-spaced typescript according to The Chicago Manual of Style (University of Chicago Press). The electronic version should be in Microsoft Word, WordPerfect, or Rich Text format (RTF).

Because submissions are evaluated anonymously, the author's name should appear only on the title page.

Length:

Manuscripts, including footnotes and bibliography, must not exceed 7,000 words.

Illustrations:

The JNEHS accepts articles with illustrations. The author shall obtain appropriate assignments or licenses from the copyright owners of the photographs, pictures, diagrams, drawings, maps and other material to be used in the JNEHS article or review, granting all rights necessary or desirable in connection with the creation, publication, and sale of the JNEHS article or review. The author agrees to pay all fees for the use of such material. The author shall provide evidence of written permission to use any copyrighted material not original to the author promptly upon the JNEHS's request. All images must be submitted electronically as a .tiff or .jpg, with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi and width of 155 mm. Please include proper citations for each image, as required by the owner, as well as any additional captions you desire. The JNEHS editor may edit captions for length.

Copyright:

Articles or reviews that are accepted become the property of the North End Historical Society. The JNEHS allows authors the free use of their materials as long as a decent interval elapses between publication in the NEHS and subsequent publication.

Unpublished:

A manuscript that has been published or that is currently under consideration for publication elsewhere in article, book, or electronic form should not be submitted. The JNEHS will not consider submissions that duplicate other published works in either wording or substance.
